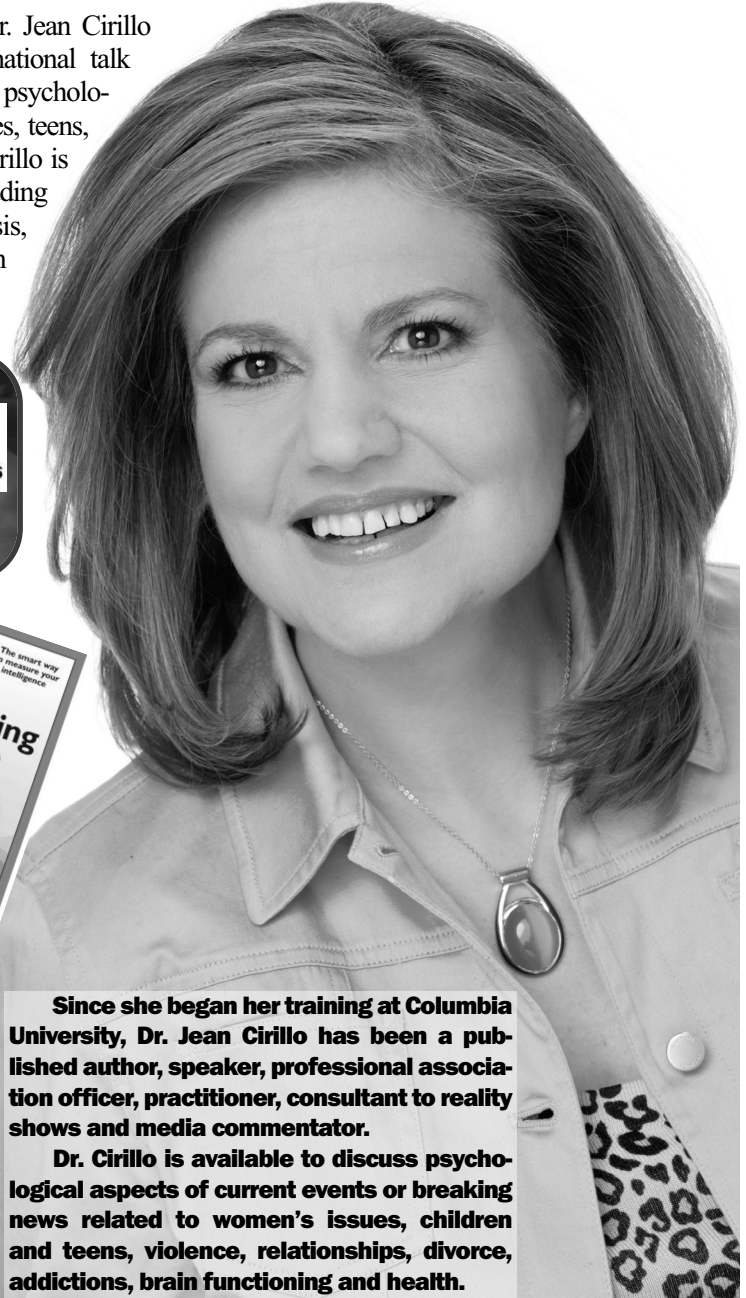
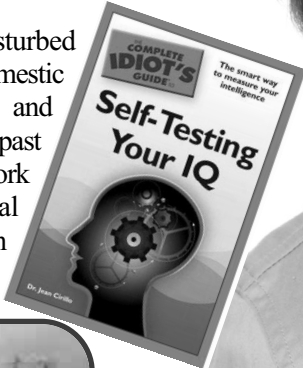




Dr. Jean Cirillo Psychologist
